## ORDINANCE NO. 391N

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GARFIELD, WASHINGTON, renumbering Ordinance No. 385N adopting the property tax increase for collection in 2011.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Garfield has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2011; and

WHEREAS, the town's actual levy for the previous year was \$57,438; and

WHEREAS, the population of town is less than 10,000; and

WHEREAS, the number 385N has been inadvertently used for two different ordinances, thereby creating confusion between the two ordinances; and

WHEREAS, there was inadvertently a clerical error in the tax year in one paragraph, thereby creating confusion in the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to renumber one of the ordinances and clarify the tax year, thereby eliminating the duplication and resulting confusion, now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Garfield as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Ordinance No. 385N, adopting a property tax increase for collection in 2011, which was passed by the Town Council at its regular meeting on July 28, 2010, is hereby renumbered, *nunc pro tunc*, to be Ordinance No. 391N for the 2011 tax year.
