APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT: Shon Clark

Water

Everything operating as normal.

Sewer

Everything operating as normal. Flows are still high with the large rainfall.

Garbage

Streets/Park

The fence is going up around the new RV Park. Once conduit is located, the project will continue and electrical will be installed. Neal Leon suggested looking at Home Depot, Platt or Stoneway. Monty has passed his written knowledge test to enter into the Class B CDL training. He will be starting Monday June 13th, and the class will be a full two weeks. Shon said two scrape metal bins have been filled. Craig Mitzimberg added that the fence going up around the RV Park is looking nice.

Shon received some bids for ultrasonic flow meters to measure flows in the sewer lines. Mayor Pfaff said the town will publish in the official newspaper a call for bids for the specific type of flow meters they are looking to purchase. Bids will include flow meters that fit 6", 8" and 10" pipes. All bids should also include the software and hardware to use the equipment. Shon will contact the companies that had already dropped off their bids and ask them to formally submit them via the bid process listed in the newspaper.

There is a road crew outside of town heading towards Oakesdale that is chip sealing the roads. The details of their work crew can be found on a reader board at the southeast side of town. Currently, they are preparing all the surfaces for the chip seal application.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Pfaff said the most recent town hire to mow the park didn't work out, so a new person needs to be contracted to get the work completed. Craig has offered to mow the town parks and Mayor Pfaff is wondering if any council members would be opposed to having Craig mow for the same rate that Rick Wride was charging the town? All council members were fine with Craig mowing the park, entrances, and servicing restrooms for the remainder of this season.
