CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pfaff called the regular town council meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT: Shon Clark

Water

Everything operating as normal. Working on that water leaks in town.

Garbage

Streets/Park

The road grader was out today, and dirt road oiling will be happening soon. At the RV Park, the conduit is in the ground and Harrison will be running wire to all the stations. Shon will have an updated time frame from them soon.

Mayor Pfaff said the garbage truck is back and Shon confirmed that one cylinder was unrepairable and was replaced. There is a minor problem with the switch that may require further work from SWS. The truck was taken to them in Spokane to save on travel expenses.

OLD BUSINESS:

Council Position #3 update. Currently no one has turned in a letter of interest so they will continue to look for a viable candidate.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Pfaff said it is time to oil roads again. There are three bids on the table for road oiling this year. Council discussed the cost per square foot and what type of product they would like to use. They are thinking they would like to try the mag chloride this year to see if it holds up better over the summer months. Mag chloride is more of a binder and will make a harder surface. Now that the roads have been graded, this will be the best time to hit them with dust abatement. Shon explained what cycle they are on for road oiling. Craig Mitzimberg thought the Mag chloride product offered by Custom Spray was the way to go. Neal Leon MOVED to approve the Custom Spray bid using the magnesium chloride product. The project will be approximately 4,440 linear feet at \$1.60 a linear foot for an approximate total of \$7,104. Connie Schaut seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
