

ORDINANCE NO. 491-N

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GARFIELD, WASHINGTON, AMENDING GARFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE 12.12.010, and those portions of ordinance No. 19-N§4 which are codified as part thereof thereby creating buffer zones for the growing, processing, or producing of cannabis for recreational or medicinal purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF GARFIELD AS FOLLOWS”

Section 1 Garfield Municipal Code Section 12.12.010 and those portions of ordinance 19-N§4 which are codified as part thereof “Public Nuisance and acts injurious to public health defined” are hereby amended to read as follows:

“12.12.010- Public Nuisance and acts injurious to public health defined:

- 1. To cause or suffer the carcass of any animal or offal, filth, or noisome substance to be collected, deposited, or remain in any place to the prejudice of others.**
- 2. To throw or deposit any offal or other offensive matter, or the carcass of any dead animal, in any water course, stream, lake, pond, spring, well, or common sewer or public highway, or in any manner to corrupt or render unwholesome or impure the water or any spring, stream, pond, lake, or well, to the injury or prejudice of others.**
- 3. To obstruct or impede, without legal authority, the passage of any river, harbor or collection of water.**
- 4. To erect, continue, or use any building or other place for the exercise of any trade, employment, or manufacture which, by occasioning obnoxious exhalations, offensive smells, or is otherwise offensive or dangerous to the health of individuals or the public.**
- 5. The growing, processing, or producing of cannabis for recreational or medicinal purposes within 1,000 feet of any elementary or secondary school, playground, recreation center or facility, child care center, public park, public transit center, library, or any game or arcade admission to which is not restricted to persons aged 21 years or older.”**


Section 2 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after it, or a summary thereof, is published in the official newspaper of the Town of Garfield as required by law.
