## **OLD BUSINESS:**

Mayor Pfaff said that he emailed to everyone the copy of the most recent preliminary 2024 budget. The insurance numbers still need to be finalized and insurance is going up another estimated \$13,000 this year. The cost of insuring police departments is rising across the state. A call will be put in with another competing insurance company to see what they might be able to offer.

Notable changes to the 2024 budget are health insurance is increasing per employee. Medical will increase about \$41 per month per employee, and vision will be added at a \$12 a month per employee cost. Council approved a 3% COLA so that will equate to

about a \$1,500 to \$2,000 increase in payroll per employee. State remittance from various taxes that they pass back to municipalities has risen significantly this year. Mayor Pfaff talked about the funds and their current positions and says the final insurance revisions will be conducted but the rise in costs is starting to impact the budget. Roni Mundell confirmed that if the fire department is wanting something other than what is budgeted, they just need to let the town know? The department is looking to get a specialized uniform washer installed at the facility. Research into options and costs will be conducted soon.

Connie Schaut <u>MOVED</u> to approve payment of bills. Roni Mundell **seconded the motion**, and the motion was carried unanimously.
