WHEREAS: There is currently no requirement under the Open Public Meeting Act, RCW 42.30, that written public comments submitted to the Town be read out loud during a council meeting; and


WHEREAS: The Town Council has determined that in the interest of orderly conduct of the Town's Council Meetings, written public comments shall be submitted to the Town 3 days before the next regularly scheduled meeting and shall not be read out loud at meetings by any staff or governing member of the Town; now, therefore

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Town Council of Garfield that it shall be the Policy of the Town of Garfield that written public comments shall be submitted to the Town 3 days before the next regularly scheduled meeting and such written comments shall not be read out loud during Town Council meetings by any staff or governing member of the Town of Garfield.
